By this writ petition the petitioners have challenged the non-bailable warrants issued against them by the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum.

In my opinion, these non-bailable warrants are issued only to secure the presence of the petitioners.

Learned counsel states that the petitioners undertake to appear before the Forum.

Consequently, it is made clear that in case the petitioners appear before the Forum the non-bailable warrants will not be executed against

them.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
