1. The petitioners will not have any remedy for consideration of admission into MBBS course that has commenced in the year 2014. The petitioners' answer to the issue of how the petition could be maintained is that they had already come by means of a challenge to the admission in September 2014 but since this court had turned down their request on a plea that they had not furnished all the requisite details and granted them liberty to file a petition with all details. They have collected all the details now and are before this court. Their own laxity, for whatever reasons not to be able to produce the requisite documents cannot afford a justification for seeking for admission to a course beyond the date which has been fixed by the Supreme Court as a last date before when a person could seek for admission as laid down in **Priya Gupta Versus State of Chhattisgarh-(2012) 7 SCC 433.**

2. The writ petition is dismissed. The remedy, if at all, could only a claim for damages for wrongful denial of admission.
