AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to release the benefit of 1st ACP Grade Pay to them on completion of 10 years of regular satisfactory service with all consequential benefits and arrears.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the petitioners have also moved a Legal Notice dated 22.12.2014 (Annexure P-6) to the respondent No.2 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide their legal notice within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter/legal notice (Annexure P-6) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioners are found entitled to any claim the same be released to them within the aforesaid period, failing which, they would be entitled to claim the same with interest @ 8% p.a. from the date/s the amount/s fell due till the date/s of payment/s.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
