Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were in the waiting list at Sr. Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6, in the process of selection for the posts of drivers in general category. Five candidates did not join. The candidate at Sr. No. 4 in the waiting list is already in Government service, hence, not likely to join. Despite the fact that the instructions issued by the Government on 7.10.1998 provide that waiting list shall remain operative for a period of one year, the petitioners were not appointed. Thereafter, two legal notices dated 6.10.2014 and 12.10.2014 were got served on behalf of the petitioners upon the respondents, however, even those have not been responded to.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, however, without opining on the merits of the controversy, respondent no. 2 is directed to take a final decision on the claim made by the petitioners in the aforesaid two legal notices in view of the latest instructions on the issue regarding appointment of the candidates from the waiting list. The needful

shall be done within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

The petition stands disposed of.
