1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents for stepping up his pay at par with the pay of his juniors.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a Legal Notice dated 17.04.2015 (Annexure P-5) to the respondent No.3 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and decide his legal notice within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter/legal notice (Annexure P-5) and take whatever action

he deems necessary as per law by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found entitled to any claim the same be released to him within the aforesaid period, failing which, he would be entitled to claim the same with interest @ 8% p.a. from the date/s the amount/s fell due till the date/s of payment/s.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
