Prayer in the present petition, is inter alia, for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner including gratuity, balance of GPF (with interest), pension (including arrears), commute pension, arrears of pay as per new pay scale from 1.1.2006 to 31.7.2009 and interest @ 15% on arrears of retiral benefits.

Learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice (Annexure P-3) however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide

the legal notice Annexure P-3, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
