AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner contends that with reference to communication dated 02.05.2011 (Annexure P-5), the petitioner was duly selected for appointment to the post of Aanganwari Worker at Village Chaunda, Block Malerkotla, District Sangrur. He contends that because the Matric certificate and the experience certificate of the petitioner had to be verified, the work was not allotted to her. The said verification has now been completed but still the petitioner has not been assigned any work. She had been visiting the office of the respondents but without any result, which led to the petitioner's serving a legal notice through counsel dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-9) upon the respondents but that also has not solicited any result.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Deputy Director, I.C.D.S., Mini Secretariat, Chandigarh-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-9) filed by the petitioner, within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Deputy Director, I.C.D.S., Mini Secretariat, Chandigarh-respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-9) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
