Short affidavit on behalf of Shri Gurjit Singh, Additional
State Project Director, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Authority, Punjab
has been filed. The same is taken on record.

Para No.6 of the said affidavit reads as under:-

“That in the light of the above said facts, after shifting IERT's as per Rationalization Policy of the Government, the IERT's were allowed to continue work, vide order (Annexure P-7) on ad-hoc basis at their present place of posting at respective block/district. That rationalization has been done for smoother withdrawal of salary of these employee's. However, there was hue and cry that few of them have been shifted to far of places. On which the subsequent order has been issued.

There is no such inconveniences or loss to these IERT's. It is mere misconception in their mind that if temporary arrangement is withdrawn they have to go at far off places. There is no such apprehension. At present, the office of deponent is not going to transfer any of the IERT's from their present place of posting and Annexure P-7 has been issued only to accommodate the IERT's at their present place of posting. Hence the apprehension of the petitioners that they are going to be transferred at far off places is totally misconceived at this stage. The deponent craves leave to file any further affidavit if the same is desired by this Hon'ble Court.

Hence it is respectfully prayed that present writ petition may kindly be disposed of in the interest of justice.”

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are satisfied and do not wish to press the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed.
