The relief claimed in the present petition is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to consider the case of the petitioner with regard to the appointment as ETT Teacher.

It is the case of the petitioner that she was successful having secured merit at Serial No.42 of the Backward Class Category by securing 51.14716 marks.

It is further contended by the counsel for the petitioner that appointment letters were issued but could not be delivered to the petitioner due to wrong postal reporting that the house was not found.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that representations have been filed with the respondents-authorities for issuance of the appointment letters and reference is made to the letters dated

22.07.2013, 24.07.2013, 31.07.2013, 06.08.2013 and 06.07.2015
(Annexures P-3 to P-7).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that if a decision is taken on the said representations within a specific time frame, he will be satisfied

Keeping in view the limited controversy, this Court does not feel it necessary to call upon the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take into consideration the aforesaid representations of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.
