Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice Annexure P-1, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of

this order.
