AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioner is seeking regularization in view of orders (Annexures P-6 & P-7).

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 11.09.2014 (Annexure P-9) which has been forwarded to the respondent No.3 by Annexure P-10 and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and decide his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-9) and take whatever

action he deems necessary as per law by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
