M.JEYAPPAUL, J.

We heard the submissions made on either side.

We find that there is no merit in the writ petition.

Inasmuch as the scheme framed for conducting examination for the post of Postal Inspector found appended as Annexure A-1 does not impose any bar on the employees, who have joined on deputation to the Army Postal Service to exercise their option for posting in other circle on selection. It is an undisputed fact that the 2nd respondent who appeared for the above post, ranked 6th in Punjab circle. There is also no dispute to the fact that he had exercised an option to be posted in a different circle, in case he could not qualify for the

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circle in which he competed.

In our view, the Tribunal has rightly held that Annexure A-1 does not put any restriction on the Postal employees who has joined on deputation to the Army Postal Service to exercise their option for posting in a different circle on selection, if in case they could not qualify for appointment in the circle where they are serving.

Petition stands dismissed.
