Reply filed on behalf of respondent No.3 in Court is taken on record.

Challenge in the present petition is to the transfer order dated 01.07.2015 (Annexure P-3) from the office of Director, Employment Generation and Training, Punjab, Chandigarh to District Bureau Employment Generation and Training, Patiala.

In the reply, it has been averred that the petitioner has already joined his duty on 30.07.2015 and the transfer was on account of the fact that the department wanted to keep him away from the preliminary inquiry initiated against him on account of fact that he was intoxicated on the intervening night of 29th/30th June, 2015. Even liquor bottles' were found in his possession while he was working as Chowkidar.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had already joined the office before approaching this Court, this Court does not feel it necessary to interfere in the said impugned order.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed.
