Challenge in the present writ petition is to the transfer order dated 29.7.2015 (Annexure P/2) whereby the petitioner has been transferred from the office of Store Procurement Division, Chandigarh to UBDC Circle, Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner's wife Smt. Sarla Devi is also employed as Junior Assistant in the office of Discharge Division, Punjab Irrigation Department, Sector 68, Mohali.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anshul Gupta, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

Counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon clause 2(b) of the policy dated 8.6.2015 (Annexure P/1). However, it is apparent that the petitioner has not approached the respondents for the said grievance.

Accordingly, without going into merits of the case and in view of the fact the petitioner has not approached the respondents for his grievance, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent No.2 for necessary relief by filing appropriate representation within one week from today. If the petitioner files such representation, the said respondent shall consider the representation in the light of the relevant policy and take a decision within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
