The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that he was appointed to the post of *Chowkidar* on *temporary/ad hoc* basis on 28.01.2000 and thereafter, he was reinstated as per award passed by the Labour Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the writ petition filed by the respondents was dismissed. The representations made by the petitioner to grant the benefit of ACP and to deduct the General Provident Fund from his salary were not considered as no action has been taken thereupon so far. Learned counsel further submits that a legal notice dated 12.05.2015 was also served upon the respondents and the same is still pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to the respondents to consider his legal notice and pass necessary order.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the

legal notice dated 12.05.2015 (Annexure P-8) and pass necessary order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, in case, the petitioner is found to be entitled for the relief claimed in the legal notice, the same be granted to him.

In case, any adverse order is passed then the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the same.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
