Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing letter dated 09.06.2014 (Annexure P/6) passed by the respondent whereby deceased-husband of petitioner no.1 has been directed to vacate the premises in question.

It is alleged by the petitioners that husband of petitioner no.1 has expired on 22.07.2013. Impugned notice dated 09.06.2014 (Annexure P/6) has been issued against a dead person and not in accordance with law.

The petitioners will be at liberty to avail any other

alternative remedy that may be available to them in accordance with law.

Needless to say that thereafter authorities shall proceed in accordance with law.

With the above observations, present writ petition is disposed of.
