LISA GILL, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner during the pendency of this writ petition, petitioner is entitled to interest on delayed payment.

In view of the substantial relief having been afforded, petitioner is at liberty to represent before the competent authority for release of interest. In case such representation is submitted within three weeks from today, competent authority shall consider the same in accordance with settled principles of law within a period of four months thereafter. Interest if found due on delayed payment, shall be released within a period of six weeks thereafter.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
