AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was assigned the work to construct the Veterinary Hospital Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib. The said work was completed on 28.03.2014 and the measurements were also done on the same day. Petitioner has been paid some of the amounts but still an amount of ₹9,94,212/- is pending with the respondents, for which the petitioner had been approaching the respondents but without any result. He has even submitted a representation dated 01.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Executive Engineer, Construction Division No.2, PWD B&R Branch, Mohali-respondent No.2, but that also has not been responded to.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 01.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) within some specified time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner,

without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to Executive Engineer, Construction Division No.2, PWD B&R Branch, Mohali-respondent No.2, to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 01.05.2015 (Annexure P-4), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to him, in accordance with law, within a further period of one month. In case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to him forthwith.
