By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to count the military service rendered during the second National Emergency from 03.12.1971 to 25.03.1977 for the purpose of pension.

The learned counsel contends that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down by this Court in CWP No. 17661 of 2013, titled as **Rajinder Singh** Vs. **State of Punjab and others**, decided on 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-1)

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to examine the case of the petitioner in the light of Annexure P-1 within eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case on examination, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the case of the petitioner is covered by Annexure P-1, in that eventuality, the necessary benefits be released within six weeks thereafter .
