AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the parties agree that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the marriage registration certificate has been issued on 13.01.2015. Mr. Hari Lal Nafri, Additional District Registrar-cum-Tehsildar, Fatehgarh Sahib, is present in Court in the contempt notice which was issued to him for non-compliance of the order passed by this Court and tenders an unconditional apology for the inadvertent mistake which has taken place on his part. He states that in future, the same situation will never be permitted to occur. He, therefore, prays for discharge of the notice in the contempt issued by this Court vide order dated 12.01.2015.
