RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

This petition has been filed against an order of transfer and posting issued by the Director Animal Husbandry, Punjab, Chandigarh, passed on 24.6.2015. The petitioner is one amongst 17 persons transferred who are mentioned in the transfer order. The petitioner has been transferred from Civil Veterinary Dispensary, Fateh Shukar-Chak, Distt. Amritsar to Civil Veterinary Hospital, Kandhola, Distt. Jalandhar. It is the petitioner's case that after the transfer order, he was diagnosed for Pulmonary Tuberculosis and is presently undergoing treatment at Sri Guru Ram Das Charitable Hospital, Amritsar, and in the course of his treatment also he has to visit the Josan Hospital three times a week for medication.

The petitioner has brought his grievance against the transfer to the notice of the Director of the Animal Husbandry, Punjab, by a representation dated 31.7.2015 but no decision has been communicated on the representation so far. In the circumstances, it appears just and

appropriate that the Director Animal Husbandry, Punjab, would take up the representation of the petitioner together with the copy of this petition; hear the petitioner in person; understand his problem; pass a speaking order thereon and communicate the same to him without delay. In case it is required then the opinion of the Civil Surgeon may be requested on the medical needs of the petitioner and if they are sufficiently met at Jalandhar for treatment of the ailment complained. It is directed that the entire process of hearing etc. will be concluded within a fortnight from the date of presentation of a certified copy of this order in the office of respondent 2. The petitioner would submit a copy of this petition to the office of respondent 2 within the next three days to be tagged with the representation dated 31.7.2015 for consideration.

The petition stands disposed of with the above directions.
