Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 for taking immediate steps in pursuance of notices dated 06.12.2013 (Annexure P-6), dated 04.03.2014 (Annexure P-8), dated 30.06.2014 (Annexure P-10) issued by respondent Nos.4 and 5 and to demolish the

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dangerous and unauthorized building shown in red colour in the site plan (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for respondent No.4-Municipal Council, Sunam states that unauthorized construction has been demolished and site plan has been sanctioned in accordance with law. She has also produced letter along with site plan in vernacular which are taken on record.

In view of above, instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However if the petitioners still feel that there is unauthorized construction, they will be at liberty to approach this Court by filing petition afresh.
