DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the revised pay scale and other consequential benefits to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the benefits claimed in the present petition have been released to the petitioner and the prayer made in the application for grant of promotion and consequential benefits, which have been granted to other similarly situated employees, is not a part of the main petition.

A perusal of documents available on the file would show that

the revised pension in view of revision of pay scales has already been released to the petitioner and after getting the benefits as prayed for in the main petition, an application has been moved for grant of promotion from the back date. The petitioner has slept over the matter for the last many years and even at the time of filing of this petition, this prayer for grant of promotion has not been made and when other benefits have been released then an application has been moved by the petitioner that he is also entitled for promotion as has been granted to other similarly situated employees.

Since all the benefits as claimed in the writ petition have been released to the petitioner, the present petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to make a representation to the authorities concerned with regard to his promotion from back date.
