JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for quashing of charge sheet issued vide letter No.14473-76 dated 08.01.2013 (Annexure-13).

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the charge-sheets in question have now been finalized and against the order passed by the competent authority, thereby, imposing penalty of stoppage of increment and withholding other retiral dues. Aggrieved against the said order, the petitioner has preferred an appeal before the competent authority. The learned counsel states that at this stage, he

will be satisfied in case, a direction is issued to the respondents to decided to appeal so preferred by him, within a stipulated period.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to make an endeavour to decide the appeal of the petitioner expeditiously, preferably, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
