The present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to promote the petitioners to the post of Assistant Sub Inspector.

It is the case of the petitioners that they have been promoted as Head Constables as per dates mentioned in Annexure P/1. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala-respondent no.4 forwarded their application for promotion to the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Jalandhar Range, Jalandhar vide letter dated 24.3.2015(Annexure P/3). It is submitted that as per Annexure P/4 respondent no.2 has also been requested for the same relief on 28.5.2015.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.2 to decide the representation dated 28.5.2015 (Annexure P/4) within some time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anshul Gupra, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought by the petitioners, this Court is of the opinion that there is no requirement of receiving any written

statement on behalf of the State.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take into consideration the representation dated 28.5.2015 (Annexure P/4) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
