Prayer in the present writ petition is for permission to make admission to 100 seats of B.Ed. Course for the session 2015-16 and that respondents No.3 & 4 be directed to allocate 100 seats and the Institute be permitted to make admissions. The prayer is on the basis that vide order dated 15.07.2015 (Annexure P1), the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) had restored the recognition of the Institute for running of the B.Ed. (2 units) and D.Ed. (1 unit).

This Court had directed the petitioner-Institute to take part in the counselling, vide order dated 10.09.2015, subject to final decision of the writ petition and the students were to be notified regarding the pending litigation.

In the short reply, filed on behalf of respondent No.3-University, to which the petitioner-Institute is affiliated, it has been averred that the matter of restoration of affiliation stands referred to the Academic Council of the University, as per the report of the Inspection Committee. The application, processing fees of Rs.1 lac, inclusive of late fees, has been submitted for continuation of reaffiliation. If the College is found fit by the Academic Council/Executive Council, the reaffiliation will be granted, accordingly.

Keeping in view the fact that the recognition, now, already stands restored, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3-University to take a decision on the said issue, expeditiously, within a period of 2 months from today. It will be open to the University to ask for the charges, as per its rules and regulations, which the petitioner-Institute will deposit. In case any adverse order is passed against the petitioner, it will be open to the petitioner to challenge the same. The provisional admissions made, on account of the interim orders of this Court, shall be subject to final decision of the University. In case the affiliation is not granted, the result of the said students shall not be declared and it will be open to the petitioner-Institute and the students to challenge the same.
