Each of the petitioner applied for a four marla plot under the oustee category. The respondents vide letter dated 6.3.2013 informed the petitioners that they are entitled to eight marla plots.

Counsel appearing for the respondents states that the petitioners will be entitled to a plot as per their entitlement. Although, the letter from the respondents states that the petitioners are entitled to eight marla plot, it would be necessary to ascertain correctness of the same.

In the circumstances, the respondents shall ascertain from the records the size of the plots that the petitioners are entitled to. The petitioners are at liberty to forward a representation to the respondents specifying their entitlement and the evidence in support thereof. The respondents shall take the same into consideration before determining the petitioners' eligibility. The respondents shall do so at least a week before the next draw.
