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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

In the instant writ petition, which has been filed by Gram Panchayat, Village Jhok Dipulana, it has been alleged that they have submitted a complaint-representation (Annexure P-3) to the District Food & Supplies Commissioner, Fazilka, respondent No.2, in which they have made allegations that Jagtar Singh, respondent No.4, who is a depot holder, has not been distributing the ration to the eligible poor persons of the village. But no action thereon has been taken despite a report of the Inspector Food and Supplies, Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage she will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the complaint-representation (Annexure P-3) made by the petitioner and take necessary action in accordance with law.

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Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the complaint (Annexure P-3) and take necessary action in accordance with law.
