Prayer in this writ petition is for directing an inquiry in the appointment of respondent No.8 on the post of Salesman being illegal on the ground that a certificate relied upon by respondent No.8 was forged among other irregularities.

While issuing notice of motion, Registrar Cooperative Societies, Punjab-respondent No.2 was directed to look into the matter and file his personal affidavit in this regard.

In compliance of order dated 12.08.2015, affidavit of A.S. Miglani, IAS, Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab was filed. In the inquiry conducted by the Deputy Registrar Cooperative Societies, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, it was found that there were number of irregularities which rendered the selection illegal. Deputy Registrar Cooperative Societies has annulled resolution dated 30th May, 2015 whereby respondent was appointed as Salesman.

In this view of the matter, learned counsel submit that present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for direction to the respondents to fill the said post after proper advertisement etc.

I do not feel that there is any necessity of issuing any such direction as it is expected that the post of Salesman would now be filled in accordance with law after following proper procedure.

Present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
