Applying the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Union of India and others Vs. Major General Shri Kant Sharma and another 2015(2) SCT 519*, this Court has held in *CWP No.6958 of 2012 dated 18.05.2015, No.675477 Ex. LAC Anil Kumar Bishnoi Vs. Union of India and others* that writ petition against the order passed by the Armed Forces Tribunal is not maintainable. Of course, the petitioner can avail the alternative remedy available under law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that review applications are pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

In the decision referred above, this Court has already dealt with the above submissions made in the connected matters.

In view of the above settled position, the writ petition stands dismissed as not maintainable.
