S. J. VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

The petitioner seeks grant of a lease/licence to manage a chemist shop in the premises of the respondents. The petitioner contends that pursuant to the notice inviting tender, two bids were received. On opening the technical bids on 3rd of July, 2014, it was found that only the petitioner's bid was responsive and the other was not. As that left only one valid technical bid, the respondents intend inviting fresh tender within one month from today. It is always open to the respondents to invite fresh tender. They are not bound to award the work to the petitioner. The statement that fresh tenders will be invited by the respondents within one month from today, is accepted.

The writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
