AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for respondent No.2-MC, Gurgaon, states that after the passing of the order dated 29.09.2014 by which the petitioners were required to pay an amount of ₹15,00,000/- per zone till the decision is taken by this Court in the matter, which has been preferred by the petitioners, an amount of ₹6,77,000/- has been paid by the petitioners, whereas they were required to pay ₹30,00,000/- per month as qua two zones, for which they had got an interim order in their favour. The amount due to the petitioners came to be more than ₹2 crores as of now. He further states that the fresh tender process is underway and the tender notice will be issued within a

period of six weeks from today and the same will be finalised within a further period of four weeks and the work allotted to the successful bidder.

In the light of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as per the statement made by counsel for respondent No.2-MC, Gurgaon. It is made clear that respondent No.2-MC, Gurgaon, may proceed against the petitioners to recover the amount due as per their liability.

The interim order dated 29.09.2014 is specifically vacated.
