The petitioner has challenged the acceptance of the tender and the allotment of work by respondent No.2-Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Nabha Road of the State of Punjab in favour of respondent No.5.

2. Respondents No. 6 and 7 were other bidders, who were not allotted the tender.
3. The only contention was that respondent No.5 tendered the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) by a demand draft and not online.
4. By an order dated 30.01.2015, the respondents were directed to take a decision on the petitioner's representation in this regard. Accordingly, a fresh decision has been taken. The petitioner desire challenging the same.

5. In the circumstances, it is not necessary to consider the relief sought in this writ petition at this stage. The petitioner is at liberty to seek the same relief in fresh proceedings, if adopted to challenge the order passed by respondent No.4 in respect of the petitioner's representation.

6. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.
