On 27.08.2014, this Court had passed the following order:-

“The petitioner states that he is senior to respondents No.4 and 5 as a Central Head Teacher. In this regard he has placed reliance on the rules of seniority which talks of continuous length of service of an incumbent on the post in that particular cadre. The petitioner, however, falls back on the length of service from the date of his initial appointment. This per se would not make any difference. In this case the petitioner became Central Head Teacher by way of promotion from Head Teacher and therefore Central Head Teacher would constitute a separate cadre unless shown otherwise. It is to be noticed that the petitioner joined service as JBT teacher and then was promoted to Head Teacher whereafter he earned his promotion as Central Head Teacher. There is no material to indicate and substantiate the plea of the

petitioner that length of service would be construed by taking into consideration the initial appointment of the petitioner as JBT Teacher. He prays for time.

Adjourned to 27.1.2015.”

Concededly, almost a year has gone by and the requisite material to substantiate the plea of the petitioner that length of service would be construed by taking into consideration the initial appointment of the petitioner as JBT Teacher, in terms of the order dated 27.08.2014, has not been placed on record.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be permitted to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
