The petitioners by way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seek quashing of order dated 16.7.2014 whereby claim of the petitioners for allotment of built up booths has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners stated that as the built up booths have been allotted to some other persons, the writ petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the same in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
