Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no. 2 and 3 to include the name of the petitioners in the voter list prepared by respondent no.3 for the forthcoming elections of the Municipal Corporation, S.A.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already moved a representation dated 31.12.2014 (Annexure P/4). Learned counsel confines his prayer with regard to the decision of representation (Annexure P/4).

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the

case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 – Municipal Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) to look into the grievance of the petitioners specifically made in the representation dated 31.12.2014 (Annexure P/4) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certificate copy of this order.
