 Contentds that the petitioner though acquitted in a criminal case registered against him failed to mention these facts while applying for the post of Constable as a result of which he is not being given appointment. His claim, however, has not been rejected as he has submitted a representation in this regard. He has also appended to the petition several other precedents pertaining to the very same selection where the writ court had intervened to grant similar benefit to the writ petitioners therein.

 Without commenting on the issue any further, I am of the considered view that this petition needs to be disposed of at this stage with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation dated

11.8.2014 (Annexure P-14) by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.
