Written statement filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2 in Court today is ordered to be taken on record. Copy of the same has been handed over to the counsel opposite.

Through the present petition the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 05.08.2015 (Annexure P-4) through which the petitioner has been transferred from Gurgaon to Ferozpur Jhirka.

The petitioner seeks quashing of the impugned transfer order primarily on the ground that the same is in violation of the transfer policy of the State of Haryana.

It is settled law that transfer policies only act as guidelines for the administrative authorities while issuing transfer orders and do not give any enforceable right to the employee to approach this Court.

Even otherwise the written statement filed on behalf of State of Haryana shows that the transfer of the petitioner is on the basis of complaints made against him by his female colleagues with regard to his misbehaviour towards them. The written statement further reveals that such like complaints had been received against him at his previous place of posting also.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the petition and order dismissal of the same.
