Present writ petition has been filed for admission in the 5th semester of the LL.B. 3 years course, commencing 2015 and for conducting the examination of the 3rd semester Interdisciplinary subject of Psychology.

Vide interim order dated 25.08.2015, this Court had directed that the petitioner would be provisionally permitted to attend his classes.

In the short reply, filed on behalf of the respondent-University, the stand taken is as under:

“(2) That the petitioner submitted his request application dated 9-9-2015 (Annexure R-1) to grant him permission to opt for the Interdisciplinary (I D) Course of the 3rd semester in the subject of Hindi,

instead of the subject of Psychology for which he had earlier opted. His said request application was forwarded to the Head of the Hindi Department of the respondent-University by the respondent No.2- (Head of his Department of Laws) as noted thereon. So, he has to attend that I D course for the 3rd semester in the Hindi Department and to complete the other statutory requirements for appearing therein. His result profile (Annexure R-2) of the last four [1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th] semesters reveals that he has Repeat/Re-appear in 2 subjects, code name LAL 506 & the I D Course, which he has yet to clear as per the Ordinances.

(3) That he has been allowed to attend classes of the 5th semester of his LL.B.(Hons.), 3-Years Course, with effect from 31-8-2015.

3. That, according to the above, nothing further survives in the writ petition.”

Keeping in view the above fact that the petitioner has to complete certain requirements and is already attending the classes, the present writ petition is disposed of, by regularizing the admission of the petitioner in the 5th semester, subject to the petitioner fulfilling the necessary conditions, as contained in para 2 of the short reply, as reproduced above.

Writ petition stands disposed of, in the above-said terms.
