Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents not to replace the petitioners who were working on contractual basis under outsourcing policy of the Government on the D.C.Rates on the posts of Helpers, Pump Operations and Clerk with some other persons against the policy and in violation of the law declared by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners submitted representation (Annexure P-4) and thereafter legal notice (Annexure P-5) was served upon the respondents. He further

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submits that identical issue as involved in the present petition has already been dealt with by this Court vide judgment dated 02.07.2013 (Annexure P-3) passed in CWP-13555-2013. He further submits that his case may be considered in the lights of judgment (Annexure P-3) by the respondents.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take decision on the representation (Annexure P-4) and legal notice (Annexure P-5) in the light of judgment dated 02.07.2013 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
