MAHESH GROVER, J.

States that the first prayer made regarding quashing of Annexure P-3/T is not pressed by him in view of the termination of the course. However, in so far as the second prayer regarding grant of exemption to the petitioner on account of his being over aged on the prescribed date would merit consideration of the respondents.

Having regard to the aforesaid, where the petitioner prays for exemption on account of his being over-aged, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to the respondents to consider the grievance as raised by the petitioner in the instant petition qua this aspect, as expeditiously as possible. The petitioner would also be at liberty to move an

appropriate representation in this regard within a period of three weeks from today. The decision on the representation made shall be taken within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
