The petitioner has filed this petition seeking directions to respondent No.1 to ensure that LPG cylinder be supplied to the general public only after duly testing as per the rules framed in this regard. It has been stated that the cylinders are being supplied to the consumers without complying with the rules and without stamping a warning sign on the cylinders so as to check the date of re-testing of the cylinders before using the same.

The petitioner has approached this court without submitting any representation in this regard to all the three Oil Companies, namely Indian Oil Corporation Limited; Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited; and Bharat Petroleum, who have been impleaded as respondents No.2, 3 and 4,

respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit detailed representations to respondents No.2 to 4, with a direction to these respondents to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, expeditiously.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, without issuing notice of motion as it will un-necessary delay the matter, we dispose of this petition with liberty to the petitioner to submit detailed representations to respondents No.2 to 4 with regard to the grouse raised in this petition. If any such representation is submitted, respondents No.2 to 4 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law, expeditiously.
