Petitioner has filed this writ petition for quashing the clause 5.2 and 5.3 of Impugned Orders dated 29.5.2014 passed by respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the respondents pointed out that under Section 111 of the Electricity Act, 2003 the petitioner has alternative effective remedy to challenge the same by filing an appeal before the Electricity Tribunal which has been constituted and is working.

In view of the above facts, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to avail the said remedy.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

If such appeal is filed within a period of 15 days from today, the Electricity Tribunal shall consider and decide the said appeal on merit expeditiously.
