Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the order dated 12.08.2015 (Annexure P-18) passed by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana vide which the election of the Society has been stayed which is scheduled to be held on 20.08.2015/24.08.2015.

Learned counsel for respondent No.6 and 7 submits that instant writ petition has been filed challenging the interim order and

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appeal is still pending before the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana. Learned counsel further contends that he has no objection, if specific direction is issued to the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana to decide the appeal/proceeding pending before him within a stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the parties state that all the parties concerned have appeared before the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana and the parties shall maintain status quo till decision of the appeal/proceeding by the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana to decide the appeal/proceeding pending before him, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order and the order passed thereon shall be communicated to the parties concerned. Till then, status quo shall be maintained by the parties.
