Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents-authorities to release electricity connection to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has submitted legal notice dated 02.12.2014 (Annexure P-5) whereby specific request was made for release of electricity connection. He further submits that identical issue as involved in the present petition has already been dealt with by this Court vide judgments dated 31.08.2012 (Annexure P-3) passed in CWP-16387-2012 and dated 15.01.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed in CWP-664-2015. He further submits that his

case should be considered in the lights of judgments (Annexures P-3 and P-4).
