The scheme lays down the maximum age limit of 36 years as on 1.1.2015. The petitioner was below 36 years on 1.1.2015. The petitioner applied for the admission to the course in D.El.ED [Elementary Teachers Training] on 2.7.2015 and his case was rejected by the computer/net as a case of overage. Since the case is clear cut and the petitioner has been able to demonstrate his case before this Court that he is within the age limitation prescribed in the terms and conditions of the advertisement regarding maximum age and the maximum age fixed by this Court in LPA No.448 of 2015; State of Punjab and another v. Wazir Kaur and another rendered on 31.3.2015 with 5 years relaxation for SC/ST candidates, it would suffice, if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the

In case hearing is required, the petitioner will be heard.
