Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing order dated 13.05.2015 (Annexure P/18) passed by respondent no.1 – Financial Commissioner whereby status quo has been ordered.

Incidentally, R.O.R. is fixed for today before respondent no.1 – Financial Commissioner, which is likely to be taken up at 11.30 A.M.

In these circumstances, both the learned counsel state that direction may be issued to the Financial Commissioner to decide R.O.R. today itself or within a week thereafter and if record is required, the same shall be summoned through special messenger.

In view of above, instant writ petition is disposed of with a

direction to respondent no.1 – Financial Commissioner to decide the R.O.R. today itself, if record is already available with him or decide it within a week thereafter. If record is required, the same shall be summoned through special messenger.
