Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing letter dated 12.08.2015 (Annexure P/4).

Affidavit dated 26.10.2015 of Mr. Sudesh Kumar, S.D.O. (Op.) Sub Division, UHBVN, Bilaspur, Tehsil Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar filed in Court today is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that affidavit

dated 26.10.2015 should be treated on behalf of all the respondents. In

the affidavit, it is alleged that in case the ABT compliant special energy meter belonging to the petitioner against account No. Y3-5LS012277011 is shifted from Sub Station to consumer's end, then the petitioner would be eligible for open access.

In view of affidavit dated 26.10.2015, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the instant writ petition has become infructuous, however, the respondents should abide by their statement made in affidavit filed today.

Disposed of as infructuous with an observation that the respondents shall abide by affidavit dated 26.10.2015 of Mr. Sudesh Kumar, S.D.O. (Op.) placed on record today.
