The petitioner is a resident of village Diyal Pura Mirza, Tehsil Phul, District Bathinda. He alleges that respondent Nos.4 & 5 who are wife and husband respectively, have encroached upon the Gram Panchayat land on the pretext of establishing a Gaushala. Certain photographs are relied upon to suggest that the construction work is in progress. The petitioner alongwith other residents of the village is said to have made a complaint dated 08.05.2015 (P-2) addressed to various authorities and then to the State Government dated 21.05.2015 (P-4). Finding no response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the plea that respondent No.4 who is a Block Samiti Member has allegedly encroached upon the Gram Panchayat land, but without expressing any views on the

merits of such allegations as the other parties have not been heard at this stage, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Bathinda and Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Bhagta Bhai Ka, respondent Nos.2 & 3, respectively, to look into the complaint said to have been made by the petitioner or other residents of the village and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
