At this stage the petitioner only seeks an order directing the Chief Administrator, HUDA to hold the inquiry and to take appropriate action as directed by order dated 04.10.2011 issued by respondent No.1. Although, the petitioner has sought the cancellation of the allotment in favour of respondent No.4 on the ground that he had forged and fabricated certain documents impersonating the petitioner. The petitioner at this stage has not sought an order for the grant of the plot in his favour. It is possible that an allotment outstanding in the name of respondent No.4 if illegal would effect the petitioner's right even if the petitioner does not succeed in having the allotment transferred in his name.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2/Chief Administrator, HUDA to comply with the order dated 04.10.2011 (Annexure P-16). The order shall be passed after affording the petitioner and respondent No.4 an opportunity of being heard.
